NSS Report 2011 - 2012

Dr. V. Raman is the PO of Unit-21, Dr. T. Arumugam is the PO of Unit-22. Dr. V. Raman and Dr. T. Arumugam of the department of Tamil took charge of the NSS Units 21 and 22 respectively for the academic year 2011-12. On 09.08.2011 hundred (100) first year students were selected for the units 21 and 22 On 11.08.2011, the area between the old and the new blocks and the area behind the chemistry department were cleaned and thorny shrubs were removed.

On 12.08.2011, The NSS conducted essay writing, poetry writing and elocution competition were conducted for students as a part of the Independence Day celebration. The front yard was cleaned for the flag hoisting. The Independence Day was celebrated on 15.08.2011 with flag hoisting. Prizes where distributed by the Principal for students who participated in the various competition and high tea was served to all the staff members and the students.

The unit has taken as its regular activity the planting of samplings and maintenance of the front garden. The works started on 09.12.2012 and was carried through various stages like weeding the ground, manuring and planting. The volunteers regularly watered the plants. On 03.03.2012 one-day camp on "Yoga" was organized at the college campus. The unit camped at Ayyampatti village from 01.02.2012 to 07.02.2012 and organized the Veterinary camp. Tree planting was done, mushroom cultivation training for the Self-Help Groups was undertaken and the volunteers along with the local school students cleaned the village Railway station and the local temple.

An "Eye Camp" was conducted for the staff and the students on 29-10-2011 by Joseph Eye Hospital and the NSS wing of Government Arts College, Trichy-22. More than 450 students were examined and 65 students were diagnosed with deficiencies.

Dr. V. Raman participated in the NSS Co-ordinator's Meet held on 15-12-2011 at Bharathidasan University and plans for the future were discussed.

A special NSS camp was conducted between 13-02-2012 and 19-02-2012 for both the units 21 and 22 at Arasangudi and Vilankulam. 100 students participated in the camp and cleaned the temple was conducted. Survey in leprosy awareness, camps and rallies were conducted and a special meeting for anti-corruption awareness, in the evening yoga practice was also given.

100 saplings were planted in the both the villages. A medical camp was organized by the Tamil Nadu AIDS control board and blood test was conducted to check the HP Level and AIDS. All the students were found to be free of AIDS.

On 01.03.2012 the 150th birthday of Swamy Vivekananda was celebrated in collaboration with Ramakrishna Thabovanam and Swamy Chadirachaker Nantha gave a special lecture on awareness file was succeed for the students.
